New Zealand Hawke's Bay

From its 6 hectare home-base on the north-west facing slopes of Roy's Hill this Hawke's Bay vineyard packs a mighty punch with the award winning wines it produces. Their La Collina Syrah has been heralded as the greatest Syrah to ever come out of New Zealand.

Wines from Bilancia (be-larn-cha) are true to the name which is synonymous with equilibrium and harmony and this has become the working philosophy of Warren Gibson and Lorraine Leheny who both studied winemaking at Roseworthy in Australia. They describe their north-west facing terraced vineyard overlooking Gimblett Gravels as Our piece of the Rhône right here in Hawke's Bay.

A small vineyard with a beautiful name, Bilancia is a winery punching well above its weight.

The goal being that the Calvert property be productive, aesthetically pleasing and sustainable for future generations. This philosophy is complimented by their winemaker, Sarah Burton, who brings a successful combination of attention to detail, patience and efficiency to the wines, and 'trusts the grapes and letting the wine speak for itself'.

Internationally recognised, Craggy Range has been voted in the Top 50 World's best wineries to visit, and named 2021's Best Vineyard in Australasia at the World's Best Vineyards Awards. Chief Winemaker, Julian Grounds is included in The Drinks Business Master Winemakers Top 100, 2020.

In July 2019 Torbreck Vintners, from the Barossa Valley, acquired Escarpment and this new partnership has enabled the building of a state-of-the-art winery.

While Larry has now retired, the story continues with new Winemaker Tim Bourne and viticulturist Rowan Hoskins. The wines are a true reflection of both Martinborough's unique terroir and the skills and experience of this team.

In the F-Series we really see Framingham's philosophy come to play and the winemakers have complete freedom to experiment, allowing them to try different takes on more traditional wines. Beware though! The smaller batches mean there's only a finite amount.

Their Estate Vineyard is BioGro Certified Organic.

In 1991 Andrew Greenhough and Jenny Wheeler, swapped the big city life for a piece of land near Nelson, called Hope, a name that wasn't lost on them at the time. The coastal climate, with lots of sunshine and nice cool nights, meant the land was ideal for winegrowing. After nearly a decade and with a focus on Sauvignon Blanc, Pinot Noir and Chardonnay Greenhough wines started to achieve national and international recognition, The Greenhough Hope Vineyard Pinot Noir 2002 topped a tasting in the UK's Decanter magazine of New Zealand Pinot Noirs earning it 5 stars and the Decanter Award. Never ones to rest on their laurels, Greenhough moved to organic farming in 2008, and gained BioGro certification. Turns out a little bit of Hope pays off.

Mates Chardonnay 2020 was voted World No.1 Wine by James Suckling. com 2021. The first white wine to gain this accolade. In a tasting in London, with some of the world's best palates in the room, Mate's, Hunting Hill, Coddington and Estate Chardonnays were put into line ups of Premier Cru and Village Burgundies. Kumeu River came first in every flight bar one where it came first equal.

Winemaker Michael Brajkovich MW was top of his class when studying winemaking at University in Australia. He went on to become NZ's first Master of Wine. Ably supported by mother Melba, brothers Paul and Milan and sister Marijana, the Brajkovich family have helped put NZ on the world winemaking map.

The everyday drinking range from Kumeu River take their name from the Village wines of France and have been hand harvested, using only indigenous yeast for fermentation and are made from grapes de-classified from the world renowned Kumeu River range. The Kumeu Village Chardonnay is fast gaining endorsement in its own right over a series of vintages. Most recently the influential Decanter Magazine rated the 2016 Kumeu Village Chardonnay at 90/100 with Michael Cooper giving it four stars and Bob Campell a score of 91/100. This is an extraordinary feat for a "second" wine and adds weight to the argument that this could be New Zealand's best value Chardonnay on the market.

The Landing

New Zealand Bay of Islands

Beautifully crafted wines with a history of 200 years in the making.

Alongside where the vineyard now sits, it is believed New Zealand's first grapevines were established nearby in 1819.

Today, first planted in 2007, The Landing respects the beauty and abundance of the land by nurturing and restoring it through sustainable viticulture. The vineyard is sited in a protective cradle of hills, enjoying a long hot growing season tempered by sea breezes off Rangihoua Bay.

The wines are 100% estate grown, handpicked and processed on-site, by winemaker Ben Byrne and consultant Warren Gibson.

Located on the water's edge at Wairoa Bay, The Boathouse looks out to 144 islands in the Bay of Islands and beyond.

Certified Toitu carbonzero in 2021, the landing sits within 1000 acres of native bush, wetland bird sanctuary and farmland.

Established in 1984, in Gisborne, on the East Coast of New Zealand, the Millton Vineyards were the first winegrowers in the Southern Hemisphere to gain the biodynamic certification, Demeter. This involves growing the grapes without the use of herbicide, insecticide, systemic fungicides or soluble fertilisers, as well as adherence to the rhythms of nature; the earth, sun, moon and beyond.... In 1989, they were also the first wine producer in New Zealand to gain BioGro certification for organic wine production.

In 2012, Millton were included in New Zealand's top 50 companies helping the environment. They have also been inducted as NZ Winegrower Fellows for their dedication to the Gisborne region.

In 1984 people thought they were crazy to grow their grapes organically. Now, it seems everybody wants to be crazy, just what this planet needs. Crazy by Nature, it makes perfect sense.

Born in Austria, Rudi brings something different to the table when it comes to wine making. From their vineyard in the Bendigo sub-region, Rudi creates a wine that will 'capture attention and entertain so that you forget everything else'.

Certified Demeter Biodynamic in 2011, with higher plant density and less yield per vine, means more intense flavour development and a mature, rich yet elegant expression of the land. It means a vineyard at peace with nature, where animals, insects, plants and vines all exist as one eco-system. The philosophy 'if you look after the land, the land will look after you' rings true for Quartz Reef. Producing New Zealand's only low sugar, organic sparkling wine, their award-winning Quartz Reef Methode Traditionelle is more than an alternative to Champagne or Cava. It is something truly special.

New Zealand Marlborough

Winemaking usually starts in the vineyard, but for the Neylon and Wiffin families it starts with the spring that lies at the heart of their lands, fed from a reservoir in the Southern Alps. Rapaura Springs isn't just the name of their brand, it represents their philosophy of protecting their water and their land, whilst making wines that are a true expression of the land. This has been achieved by a hands-off kind of approach, allowing the vineyards to tell their story with a small helping hand from their expert team of winemakers. Well sometimes small, they did just put in a new \$3 million winery wash down water treatment meaning 100% of that water is recycled.

With a slew of awards to their name, it is fair to say they are a showcase for what the region of Marlborough has to offer.

Situated in McLaren Vale, South Australia, one of Australia's oldest and best wine growing regions, is Coriole. Run by the Lloyd family, their first wine was released in 1969 and now over 50 years later this family business is still going strong.

As well as their renowned Shiraz, Coriole has taken a leadership role in bringing new grape varieties to the McLaren Vale in order to open up many new wine making and food pairing possibilities. As pioneers of Sangiovese in the region they have also introduced Australia to both Fiano and Piquepoul.

Striving to be sustainable, Coriole are toiling hard to regenerate natural vegetation in the soil and ensure that all water is recycled. They've also installed no less than 335 solar panels on the property, and managed to offset carbon emissions to the equivalent of planting 850 trees a year.

Now the brothers have Dune, a vineyard located in the sandy soils of Blewit Springs (a subregion of McLaren Vale), where they produce their own vibrant wines and get to implement and showcase all that they've learnt in the industry so far including planting Mediterranean grape varieties such as Negroamaro, Nero d'Avola and Cinsault. Don't be bamboozled by the names, they all taste great! But be sure to read the back labels as you'll find suggestive food pairing and discover the true meaning of wine's relationship with food.

The brothers farm organically, although being a new project they are yet to be certified.

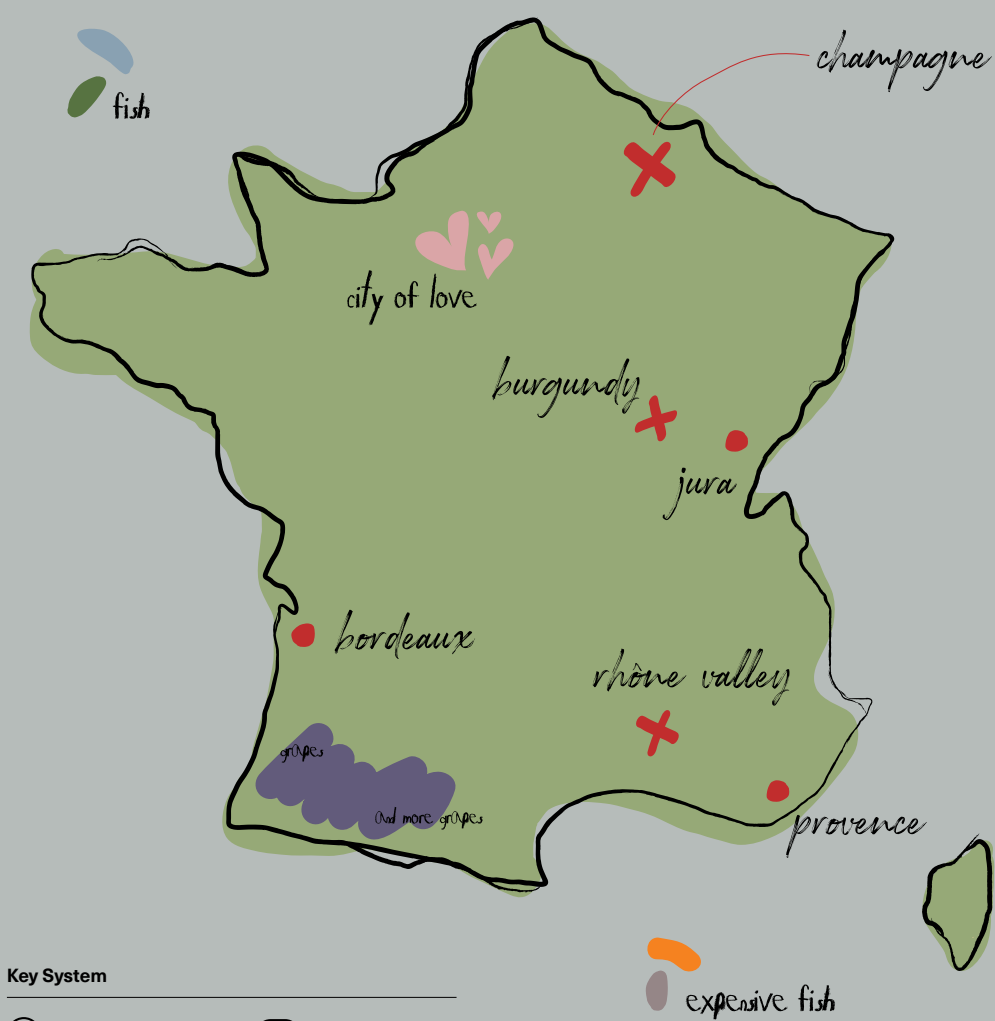

With 288 hectares, Taittinger has some of the best vineyards in Champagne and sustainability is at the core of their vineyard practice. Taittinger Champagne is characterized by a high proportion of Chardonnay grapes which, combined with a longer ageing process than is required, gives the wine a lightness and delicacy that is the hallmark of their success and popularity.

Unique wines in the portfolio include Les Folies de la Marquetterie a single vineyard wine named after a stunning chateau located on the family property, and the midnight blue label of Prélude Grands Crus, made from 50% each of Chardonnay and Pinot Noirs all from Grand Cru vineyards. Some connoisseurs rate this as one of Champagnes greatest treasures.

Always a vintage cuvée, Comtes de Champagne is made of 100% Chardonnay grapes, all from the Côte des Blancs vineyards. After nearly ten years in the cellars under Saint-Nicaise, this exceptional cuvee finally sees the light. It is a study in power and elegance.

The quality is such that only some years are declared vintages for Blanc de Blancs, and even less for Rosé, giving these wines a legendary status among the top wines from the Champagne region.

Comtes de Champagne symbolises the Taittinger mission to not only excite the palate with a range of exquisite sensations but to also touch the very depths of the soul and leave an indelible mark.

Chateau de Hartes

France Bordeaux

The Mazeau family have been farming grapes in Bordeaux, since 1928. Today Philipe Mazeau heads the family business, ably supported by daughter Oriane as winemaker and son Xavier who oversees sales and marketing (and surfing when time permits). The family have three Estates in the Entre deux Mers district, a region of beautiful farmland between the Garonne River to the south and the Dordogne River to the north. At Chateau de Hartes, the average vine age is 35 years. These vines are predominantly made up of Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon, varieties synonymous with Bordeaux.

A change in viticultural practice towards a more natural way of farming has seen the return of deer, boars, rabbits and other small animals, all coexisting between the vines. It's a picturesque scene that makes sense. The presence of nature in the vineyard helps soil regeneration and contributes towards more consistent yields.

Chateau Toutigeac

An historical site, Chateau Toutigeac is located on a picturesque hillside in the heart of the Entre de Mers district of Bordeaux. The escutcheon of their logo is from a tall stone cross that dates to the 12th Century when the monks of St Gerard founded a small community here, planted vines and built a church.

The Mazeau family have been farming grapes in the region since 1928. With three estates in Bordeaux, the 40 ha Chateau Toutigeac Estate has been in the family the longest.

The vineyards are planted in a mix of Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon supported by lesser amounts of Semillon and Muscat. Today the properties are run as a family affair with Phillipe Mazeau ably supported by his daughter Oriane as winemaker and son Xavier, in charge of sales and marketing.

Domaine Maire & Fils

France Côtes du Jura

The Jura wine region sits across the river from Burgundy and while small, has remarkable diversity. It covers 80 kilometres between Burgundy and Switzerland, and has a history of growing grapes that dates back to 312AD. Geography and ancient soils combine with a continental climate to provide ideal growing conditions for vineyards. High altitude and freezing winters give a delightful freshness to these award-winning wines and since the late 2000s Jura has caught the imagination of sommeliers and wine amateurs worldwide.

The main varieties grown are Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, but Jura's distinctive grape variety, is the white SAVAGNIN, also called Naturé which gives a distinct roundness and complexity to the wines.

For several generations the Boisset family have patiently built up one of the largest and greatest estates in the area, focused on key appellations. The Domaine Maire et Fils, now covers 234 hectares producing all the grape varieties of the region.

It was during the 1970s and 1980s that Robert Skalli of Maison Fortant, a firm believer in the Languedoc's potential, convinced local wine growers to replant their vineyards with better and more suitable vines. This revolutionary idea has led to the region growing in reputation and allowing for the creation of some truly superb wines. Their Rosé de Provence is an example of what they are capable.

With a history full of eminent personalities it is fair to liken their Rosé to a Ferrari Daytona or an Aston Martin Vanquish, beautiful to look at, and a little bit flashy. However, it is under the hood where the real magic happens. With the winemaking process undertaken under the watchful eyes of the Perrin family, the result is a rosé that is fresh, elegant and all round delicious.

Prosper Maufoux, a notary by trade, left his practice to pursue his passion for wine. In 1860 he set up his own firm in Santenay, a Burgundian village in the heart of the vineyards in Southern Cote d'Or. The move proved to be auspicious as the winery went from strength to strength. Today Prosper Maufoux is looked after by Eric Piffault, whose family is also deeply involved in Burgundy's tradition of winemaking. His great-great grandmother, Marie Ambal founded Veuve Ambal, one of France's great sparkling wine houses. With his customary upbeat spirit Eric has brought a new energy to Prosper Maufoux and reinvigorated the wines with the singular goal of quality. Nadine Gublin, the first female Winemaker of the Year, has joined the project and it is proving to be a winning collaboration. Burgundy has a long tradition of producing great wines, and at its heart are those of Prosper Maufoux.

A family business through and through, Veuve Ambal was founded in 1898 by Marie Ambal at a time when Champagne and their neighbouring regions were making great strides in the development of bottle fermented sparkling wines. A pioneer of her time and certainly not one to let an opportunity pass her by, Marie Ambal decided to develop her own vineyard in Burgundy where she not only made Pinots but also a high-quality sparkling wine. This was the beginning of the Veuve Ambal we know and love today. Currently the company is looked after by her great grandson, Eric Piffault and his son Aurelien. While it can't be called Champagne (as Burgundy is not in the Champagne region) do not for a second think this is a second quality drop of wine. With awards being won as early as 1908, Veuve Ambal is now one of the largest producers in Burgundy.

All Veuve Ambal domains are managed with sustainable methods, something that is at the core of the family ideology.

Together they combated economic adversity and produced a Grenache (Garnacha in Spanish) that is now widely recognised as being both of high quality and readily affordable. Borsao, ensure they still give back to the community by supporting care for the elderly, as well as those recovering from addiction through the Proyecto Hombre project.

In Bodegas Borsao, you have a brand that is intrinsically connected and authentic to the region around Zaragoza, and who produce one of the best Grenache in the world.

Nowadays a train from Barcelona arrives at Vilafranca, directly opposite the large oak doors of Bodegas Pinord, behind which you'll find the beating heart of their bottle fermented sparkling wine operation. Specialists in making Cava, the vines of Bodegas Pinord are situated on the fertile plateau in the Penedes region, just inland from the Mediterranean Sea. The grapes growing here, native varieties such as Macabeo, Parellada and Xarello, provide an oasis of greenery in an otherwise traditionally dry Catalan landscape. The wine itself is soft and aromatic, with a steady sparkle and is a perfect complement to Catalonia's rich culture.

Martin Codax

Spain Pontevedra

Founded in 1986, Martin Codax is a specialist in estate-grown Albariño with the grapes sourced from over 300 family vineyards. Located to the north of Rias Biaxas in Galicia, it is unlike any other wine growing region in Spain. It is green and cool with vineyards situated along the Atlantic coast, exposed to the salt from the sea. Here the native Albariño variety thrives, thicker skinned with higher levels of sugar and acidity, these white wines are both lively and refreshing. The success of Albariño in this region dates to Roman times and in 1988 Albarino in Galicia was recognized with a D.O.C classification (Denomination of Origin).

Very much a “winery by the people for the people”, the people of Martin Codax have a right to be proud, drinking a glass of their Albariño takes you to the coast of the Atlantic, and is a perfect introduction to life in Galicia.

The only winery in the region to focus solely on white wines, Nivarius is destined to become a benchmark for Rioja wines. The project has sought out specific vineyard sites, often at altitudes of 800m or more, where indigenous white varieties can slowly ripen to produce wines with superb texture and complexity. Produced from rare varieties, that were once at risk of extinction, and using farming practices with little intervention and respect for biodiversity, these vineyards are producing some astonishing fruit.

Each small plot is vinified separately. In a normal year Nivarius can have up to twenty different vinifications depending on the variety, estate or area where the grapes come from.

At its entry level, Nivarius celebrates the expressive characteristics of Tempranillo Blanco, a fresh, lively, perfectly ripe wine that is a joy to drink.

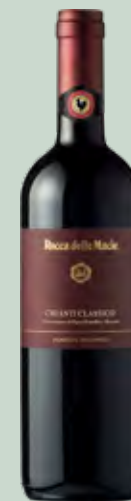

Through their wines, Villa Sandi brings you a taste of the beauty that Northern Italy has to offer.




- 2.2 Every attempt will be made to supply goods at the price quoted, however prices are subject to change without notice and the price will be the price ruling at the time of dispatch.
- 2.3 No order shall be binding on Vintners until accepted in writing by Vintners or a person authorised on its behalf.

3. Payment

- 3.1 Payment is due in accordance with the terms set out in the Customer's account application or if no such terms are stipulated by the 20th day of the month following the date of purchase. Unless Vintners has agreed to deliver the goods to the Customer's premises, Vintners delivery obligations shall be limited to making the goods available at Vintner's premises. Where Vintners has agreed to deliver the goods to the Customer's premises, the Customer shall ensure that the carriers will have uninterrupted access to the Customer's premises to enable the goods to be delivered by the carriers. Where the goods are not collected by the Customer within seven days of notification that the goods are available for collection or, where the goods are to be delivered to the Customer's premises and access is not provided to the carriers the Customer shall pay Vintners upon demand such amount calculated by Vintners as will compensate Vintners and the carriers for wasted time and expenditure and any storage charges.
- 4.2 Where Vintners has agreed to deliver the goods to the Customer's premises Vintners will pay transportation costs for orders of \$240.00* or more. Orders that do not meet the above are subject to a charge of \$12.00* per order. If an address is deemed to be rural by Vintners chosen carrier, an additional charge of \$12.00* per order will be applied.
- *These rates are subject to change.
- 4.3 The Customer will promptly check for correctness of deliveries made by Vintners. No liability will be accepted for any shortages, breakages, or defective goods unless Vintners is notified in writing within 24 hours of delivery. Returns will only be accepted within one month from the date of invoice and must be accompanied by the invoice.
- 4.4 Orders may not be cancelled and goods returned for credit except in accordance with clause 4.3.
- 4.5 Vintners reserves the right to refuse goods for credit if the goods are not of a merchantable quality. Merchantable quality is defined by but not limited to goods that have been refrigerated, stored in ice or water, have label or closure damage: do not contain the specified product & volume.
- 4.6 A collection charge of \$25 will apply for all non delivery issue related stock returns.

5. Risk and Ownership

- 5.1 Risk in any goods supplied by Vintners to the Customer shall pass when the goods are delivered to the Customer or into custody on the Customer's behalf and it shall be the Customer's obligation to insure the goods from that time.
- 5.2 Title to and ownership of the goods shall not pass to the Customer until all moneys payable to Vintners (whether for the goods or otherwise) have been paid by the Customer in full. Until title in the goods passes to the Customer, the Customer must:
- 5.2.1 Keep the goods in good condition;
- 5.2.2 Keep the goods fully insured to their full replacement value against all risks;
- 5.2.3 Not encumber the goods in any way;
- 5.2.4 Hold and keep the goods separately from other property in the possession of the Customer and in a manner which enables the goods to be easily identifiable as goods supplied by Vintners.

- 5.3 If the Customer resells the goods or any of them before payment is made the Customer shall hold the proceeds of resale of the goods or any of them in trust for Vintners and account to Vintners for all moneys owed by the Customer to Vintners. If the Customer resells the goods or any of them so as to create a debt owed to the Customer, the Customer hereby assigns all legal and equitable title to that debt to Vintners and the Customer hereby irrevocably appoints Vintners as its attorney with all powers permitted by law for the purpose of effecting any such assignment and recovery of any such debt in the name of the Customer for the benefit of Vintners.
- 5.4 Vintners shall be entitled to repossess all goods which it claims belongs to it at any time without notice and for such purpose it shall be lawful for Vintners and/or its agent to enter any premises where such goods are or are believed to be and to remove such goods. The Customer hereby indemnifies and agrees to hold harmless Vintners against any damage howsoever caused in relation to such entry and removal including consequential loss or damage to any third party or to the Customer.

6. Personal Property Securities Act 1999

- 6.1 The Customer acknowledges that Vintners holds a "security interest" in the wine and branded material and any money proceeds from the sale of the said goods pursuant to Section 17 of the Personal Property Securities Act 1999 ("the PPSA") and that Vintners may register a financing statement in respect of the said goods and any sale proceeds (together with any other goods and any sale proceeds of those goods) in accordance with the provisions of the PPSA.
- 6.2 The Customer waives its rights to receive a verification statement in respect of any financing statement or financing change statement registered by Vintners under clause 6.1.

7. Branded Material

- 7.1 Vintners may from time to time loan marketing and promotional materials accessories and products bearing brands exclusively marketed through Vintners to the Customer. The Customer shall use such materials and products only to serve or promote the product associated with that brand. If any such materials or products require replacement or renewal of parts during the time it is in possession of the Customer, then the Customer will pay the costs of the renewed or replaced parts whether or not the need for renewal or replacement arises during the course of normal use and general wear and tear or arises as a result of misuse by the Customer. Vintners may demand return of any such materials and products at any time. The Customer will pay for any materials and products not returned to Vintners.

8. Warranties and Liabilities

- 8.1 Save for any warranties and conditions conferred in writing by Vintners on the Customer in relation to particular goods sold by Vintners to the Customer, Vintners makes no representation and gives no assurance, condition or warranty of any kind to the Customer (including any assurance, condition or warranty implied by law to the extent that the assurance, condition or warranty can be excluded) in relation to the goods and accepts no liability for any assurance, condition, warranty, representation, statement or term not expressly set out in these terms and conditions. The Customer specifically acknowledges that where it is acquiring the goods for business purposes the provisions of the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 are excluded.
- 8.2 Vintners will replace with reasonable despatch any defective goods subject to compliance by the Customer with the provisions of clause 4.3.
- 8.3 The benefit of any warranties and conditions conferred by Vintners on the Customer are personal to the Customer and are not assignable.
- 8.4 Vintners shall not be liable to the Customer or any other person for any indirect or consequential loss or damage of any kind arising out of defective goods or any breach by the Company of its warranties or conditions or obligations under these terms and conditions or negligence or otherwise. Regardless of the legal basis of any claim, Vintner's maximum liability to the Customer under any circumstances is limited to a sum not exceeding the invoiced value of the goods.

9. Information

- 9.1 The Customer authorises:
- 9.1.1 Vintners to obtain any information concerning the Customer's affairs that Vintners deems necessary.
- 9.1.2 Any reputable credit agency and any other person to provide Vintners with any information which Vintners regards as relevant to the Customer's credit activities and credit worthiness.
- 9.1.3 Vintners to provide to any credit reporting agency and any other person any information about the Customer's credit activities and credit worthiness.
- 9.1.4 Vintners to utilise any information provided by the Customer for the purpose of marketing its goods or services.
- 9.2 To the extent required under the Privacy Act 1993 the Customer is entitled to have access to and to request correction of personal information concerning the Customer which has been collected by Vintners.

10. Force Majeure

- 10.1 Vintners shall not be responsible to the Customer for failure to perform any of its obligations due to causes beyond its control including work stoppages, fires, civil disobedience, riots, rebellions, acts of God and similar occurrences. In such circumstances Vintners shall have the right at its discretion to delay the performance of its obligations until such causes cease or to cancel the whole or any part of the contract without incurring any liability to the Customer.

11. Governing Law

- 11.1 Vintners and the Customer both acknowledge that these terms and conditions, and any agreement agreed in writing between the parties which expressly refers to these terms and conditions, contain the entire understanding and agreement between them and that there have been no representations made by either party to the other except as expressed in these terms.
- 11.2 If any provision of these terms is found to be invalid, void, illegal or unenforceable; the validity, existence, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions will not be affected.
- 11.3 These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of New Zealand.
